## Summer School Opportunities!!

Mr. Kenworthy has offered school leaders the opportunity to offer Summer School! We will have Summer School at Osceola Middle School from June 15 through July 2. The program will begin at 9:00 AM and finish up at 1:00 PM. Here are the tentative program offerings:

Summer Science Camp: open to all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students attending OMS and YMS for the 2015-2016 SY (rising 8<sup>th</sup> graders). Teachers will focus on conceptual understanding/project-based learning in order to get a head-start on the eighth grade science standards. Transportation would be provided (limited number of stops), and students will be fed breakfast and lunch.

Summer Math Camp: open to all 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade Level 1-2 students (based on 2013-2014 FCAT scores) attending OMS and YMS for the 2015-2016 SY. Teachers will focus on conceptual understanding/foundational math skills/project-based learning. Transportation would be provided (limited number of stops) and students will be fed breakfast and lunch.

Summer Course Recovery: open to any student needing to recover courses and currently attending OMS and YMS. Depending on need and space, priority may be granted to upper classes and/or number of courses to be recovered. Transportation would be provided (limited number of stops), and students will be fed breakfast and lunch.

Students with perfect attendance for Summer School Math or Science will qualify for an incentive trip at the end of the program. Non-binding intent letters were sent out on Monday. We will send out more information next month!!

# **Change Coming for Quarter 3 Awards**

We have had a lot of discussion centered around our Quarter 2 Awards Ceremony and considerations about the proximity to state testing. For these and other reasons, we are planning on having one combined awards ceremony for all students, grades 6-8, beginning at 9:00 AM on April 7, 2015. In so doing, our aim is to continue to value your time. Our preliminary numbers include 192 GPA Awards (including 3.0-3.49, 3.5-3.99 and 4.0 Awards). In order to keep the ceremony to just under an hour, we are planning to recognize 3.0-3.49 GPAs at an event other than the Quarter 3 Awards Ceremony on April 7. Therefore, at that time, we will recognize 88 GPA Awards (for 3.5 and above). The approximately 100 students receiving a 3.0-3.49 GPA Award will receive a certificate at a separate reception for them alone. All students invited to participate in our Quarter 3 Awards Ceremony should have a sticker on his/her report card.
