

Parent Notifications

As required by Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), the following information is annually shared with parents. The distribution of this document shall serve as a formal notification to parents regarding the following issues:

Right to Request Information

Each parent of a student in a Title I school has the right to request information about the professional qualifications of the student's teacher(s) and any teacher assistants who serve the student. Parents also have the right to request information on policies regarding student's participation in assessments and procedures for opting out. This information will be provided by the administrative office at the child's school upon request. This notice will also be provided by the school to all parents.

Parent Notification Regarding Teachers without State Qualifications and Certification Requirements

The federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires schools that receive Title I, Part A funds to notify parents or legal guardians when their child has been taught for four (4) consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not met "applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned." If this occurs, your child's school will send home a letter giving you information regarding your child's teacher.

Osceola Middle School Parent & Family Engagement Plan Summary

In support of strengthening student academic achievement, Osceola Middle School receives Title I, Part A funds and therefore must jointly develop with, agree on with, and distribute to parents and family members of participating children a written parent and family engagement plan that contains information required by Section 1116 of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). The plan outlines the various components of Family Engagement, including: (1) how the school will coordinate with other federal programs, (2) the various family engagement meetings it will hold, (3) how it will build the capacity for strong family engagement, and (4) how it will communicate with parents.

Family Engagement

The school will make automated phone calls when necessary to inform parents of the events that are taking place at the school. The school will also use the Remind application to inform subscribed parents of upcoming events. In addition to calling home and using Remind, we will send home a monthly Warrior newsletter with information about upcoming events.

The Family Engagement Committee (FEC) is responsible for hosting at least four events throughout the school year. The Committee will hold two planning meetings prior to each event held. Two weeks prior to the planning meeting, notices will be sent home to invite parents to participate in our planning meetings.

Parent Meetings

Osceola will provide varying meeting times for all workshops and meetings to accommodate multiple schedules. Majority of events will be held in the evening. Childcare will be offered as needed. We will also ensure that all the parents who have given their email addresses to the Family Engagement Committee will receive all the minutes from the meetings. FEC will survey for convenient times and additional needs.

Supporting Partnerships

Osceola Middle School will build the capacity for strong Family Engagement by providing access to an open computer lab at the school at least one time per week. Parents are invited to come and use the lab to check Skyward, support academic programs such as i-Ready, or use the computers for personal use. Other parent involvement activities will include academic nights focusing on Reading, Science & Science Fair, and student test scores and standardized tests.

Other Activities

Osceola Middle School will provide parents with information on student achievement, discipline data, and school budgets through PTO and SAC meetings.

Professional Development for School Staff

The school will provide the following training in the area of Family Engagement to its staff:

Communication

Osceola Middle School will communicate with parents through a variety of techniques. Newsletters will be sent home in both English and Spanish as well as posted on the school website. The school will send out at least one automated phone call and newsletter a month to inform parents of upcoming events. We will also use the Remind application to inform parents of upcoming meetings/events. After each event, parents will complete a survey online to give the school feedback and to make any requests or give any suggestions (these surveys will be given on campus after/ during the parent workshop). Information will be provided to parents by newsletter, website, Facebook, and recorded phone calls made via Blackboard Connect. Newsletters and/or Blackboard Connect will be used to provide timely information to parents. The school will monitor that the information was provided through end-of-year climate surveys and parent feedback.

Full Participation in all School Activities

Osceola Middle School will provide opportunities for parental participation through many methods. A member of the Family Engagement Committee is bi-lingual; she will translate as needed during the meetings. All parents will be receiving e-mails/letters and phone calls regarding all events and meeting dates.

All information will be translated into an understandable language for the parent. In the event that a parent with disabilities needs additional assistance, those services will be available at the school upon request.
